The knowledge you have gained from your past experience of auditing management control practices and information systems will be applied in your work as you document systems, assess risk and risk mitigation strategies, develop and execute audit programs and, assess the results. Your strong written and verbal communication skills will be demonstrated through the appropriateness of your audit recommendations and the communication of your findings to management.

Typically, this knowledge is gained through an undergraduate degree in business administration or commerce and relevant work experience, supplemented by a CA, CMA, CGA or a CIA or CISA designation.

You will utilize your strong analytical and problem solving skills to identify and develop new ideas, and evaluate and interpret data, systems and controls. You must be able to work successfully both independently and as part of a team. Additionally, you will have the organizational skills and ability to work on multiple projects at one time to ensure their timely completion.

You must be available to travel across the province with occasional overnight stays. You will be required to obtain and maintain an SLGA Gaming Regulator Certificate of Registration.
