

## The K.W. Snipes Regional and K.W. Snipes Worldwide Awards

This award is present to a small, medium, Large and very large chapter each year. The award, established in 1989, provides recognition to those chapters who meet or exceed special service goals by actively supporting local membership and thus the IS audit and control profession. Criteria assessment was based on the Chapter Activity Reports submitted annually to International Headquarters. Chapter performance is assessed on the following criteria:

- Chapter membership growth
- Member service projects
- Chapter-sponsored educational events
- Attendance at chapter meetings
- Involvement on association committees, or with association activities
- Involvement with other professional organizations
- Compliance with International Headquarters

For the first time in it's almost 25 year history the ISACA Winnipeg Chapter was awarded the K.W. Snipes Award for best medium size chapter. The 2006 K.W. Snipes North American Award for a medium size chapter and the 2006 KW Snipes Worldwide Award for a medium chapter were present to the ISACA Winnipeg chapter.
